Emma represents leading pharmaceutical and medical-device companies in high-stakes litigation, helping them build a compelling scientific narrative of the case. Emma is trial counsel for Bayer in litigation involving the herbicide Roundup, including in a recent St. Louis trial where she and partners Tarek Ismail and Shayna Cook secured a complete defense verdict. Emma also coleads the national science team in litigation involving Merck's HPV vaccine Gardasil. And, she was a key member of the team that secured landmark Daubert victories in two separate Mirena MDLs.

Emma maintains a robust *pro bono* practice focusing on reproductive justice, choice, and access to care. She recently led a Goldman Ismail team advocating on behalf of women who received coerced, unindicated, and unconsented gynecologic care while in immigration detention. She also cochairs the Reproductive Justice Working Group of the Law Firm Antiracism Alliance, an organization that aims to harness the resources of the private bar in the effort to end systemic racism.

Representative Litigation

Gardasil Litigation

Co-leads the expert and science team in state and federal litigation involving Merck's HPV vaccine. Recently, Merck tapped Emma to present at the MDL Science Day on Gardasil's safety, effectiveness, and the lack of reliable scientific support that Gardasil causes the injuries plaintiffs allege.

In re Roundup Products Liability Litigation

Trial counsel for Bayer, including *Ferro v. Monsanto*, tried to a full defense verdict in November 2022, where Emma cross-examined both of plaintiffs' general causation experts. Since 2018, Emma has played a leadership role on the national science and expert team in nationwide Roundup products liability litigation, taking key depositions of plaintiffs' causation experts, advising on overall strategy, and developing science themes (and experts to deliver them) that reshaped litigation-wide defensive strategy.

Consumer Electronics Litigation

Represented a Fortune 10 consumer-electronics company in patent-infringement cases relating to telecommunications, user-interface, computer-security, and battery technologies. Following the dismissal of several of these suits, the remaining actions are pending in the summary-judgment and discovery phases.
